Dozens of new newspapers and magazines, private radio stations and TV studios have been established and are in the process of formation since the first years of independence. The ideological direction of these publications, the issue of spirituality in the published articles is one of the most pressing issues. These issues, which need to be addressed directly by the publishing house and the editor-in-chief, should be on the minds of the nation's leaders - the intelligentsia. As long as we are the children of this nation, none of us has been given the right to entertain its moral values, the experiences of the soul. In a number of private publications, the "creations" that are constantly being published can be interpreted as an attack on the nation's spirituality. Shame, honor, pride, which is a bright expression of the Uzbek mentality (folk proverbs "A young man is ashamed - dead", "Shame is harder than death") Our colleagues, who are earning money, also have a responsibility to independence. In some private newspapers, we come across stories and narratives that lead to violence, prostitution, and sexuality. Here we are talking about the activities of non-governmental publications, and as we express our attitude to sexual stories and articles in most newspapers, the purpose of opening such a newspaper is to make money, to make a profit. But this should not be at the expense of the people's spiritual depravity, narrowmindedness, because it is a market economy. We were

surprised by the firm conclusion that "supply and demand". It is true that supply and demand play an important role in a market economy.

But how accurate is it to define spirituality by the laws of the market? Let us recall that the great writer Abdullah Oadiri in his novel "Last Days" could not have described the moments of Otabek and Silver in a veiled, mysterious and at the same time attractive way, but in an open, low way in five or six volumes. No, our writer wouldn't do that, to be exact. Because Abdullah Qadiri's inner glory, love for the nation, true human qualities - modesty, honor, pride - would not allow. Such examples can be cited as desired. The light that illuminates such works from the inside is devotion to the Motherland, to the people, to human love. Most private publications today do not have criteria. For them, noncriteria is a criterion, non-ideology is an idea. One wonders whether the authors of immoral and utterly non-national adventures were brought up in an Uzbek environment. It is also painful that low-quality music videos and movies, which are constantly broadcast on music channels, convince people, make them laugh and cry when the time comes. The media, called the Yellow Press, shouts and denounces immorality on the first page, but on the second page it destroys the same spirituality and culture. It's not about watermelon songs, "fake" movies or some media outlets that can't keep their word, it's about the immense damage they do to the people's spirituality, morality and sincere understanding. How can this problem be effectively combated? Of course, the social networks created on the Internet today, along with their positive aspects, are influencing the morale of young people with their negative consequences.

The controversies of famous artists in these fields, their coverage of family and personal lives, have reached a borderless level. Ordinary people do not even think about the negative impact on their spiritual well-being, foreign travel, and the sight of their newborn children, especially the spirituality of ordinary young people. it would be good if they set an example of their other practical work as representatives of spirituality and culture. For example, if they tell about the works of art or movies, plays they read these days, or about supporting needy families or talented but not well-off young people in our society, they will be the successors and promoters of our national values. was possible. Some link these processes to democracy. Democracy does not mean chaos. In fact, the concept of democracy is not unique to the West or the East. Its emergence is associated with the development of the general mind of the conscious person, the emergence of new aspects of cognition. And that's exactly what happened in both places. The simple and unchanging essence of democracy is freedom of conscience! We know very well that behind the word "conscience" there are such subtle qualities as patriotism, nationalism, humanity, faith, loyalty, shame, honor, shame, and Andisha, which are colored by high spirituality.
